ABOUT THE JOUSSOT-DUBIEN AWARD

This award has been created to honor the life of Professor Jacques Joussot-Dubien (1928-2009), director of ENSCBP from 1982 to 1986 in recognition of his very important impact on the future development of the graduate school as well as his actions in favor of international scientific exchanges. He was not only the key figure in establishing a graduate school closely connecting Chemistry and Physics, but also an outstanding scientist with the highest national and international recognition especially in the field of photochemistry.
