
POST GRADUATION IN PHYSICAL EDUCATION DOCTORATE



The Coordination of the Post-Graduate Program in Physical Education, offered in full association by the Department of Physical Education at UFV and by the Faculty of Physical Education and Sports at UFJF, makes public that registrations for the selection of candidates will be open. PhD course, in a continuous flow selectio schedules, from April 1st to October 15th, 2021.

The Graduate Program in Physical Education is structured in the focus research area entitled "Exercise and Sport", with the following research lines:

a) Physical activity and health.

Study of the effects of physical activity and physical inactivity in different population groups.

b) Study of Sports and its manifestations.

Study of physiological, socio-cultural, historical, psychological aspects and how they affect or are affected by sport.

3. Registration

The selection for the Doctorate in Physical Education will be made through the system of student entry in a continuous flow, with predetermined periods of enrollment and selection, and according to the availability of vacancies for supervisors.

Three selection processes will be foreseen during the year 2021, with the candidate being able to participate in only one of them during the year. He / she will only be able to participate in another process in the same year if his / her application is rejected (that is, he / she does not participate in the selection process). The number of places offered by an advisor will be announced from the first day of registration of each period.

The registration will be done by sending the documentation to the e-mails ppgefi@ufv.br and ppg.faefid@ufjf.edu.br

The candidate's registration will imply knowledge and tacit acceptance of the rules and conditions contained in this notice, in relation to which he will not be able to claim ignorance.

People with disabilities (PwD) must inform the Graduate Program, upon registration, so that the accessibility conditions and others that enable their participation with equality in the selection are provided.

Registration periods *:

1st selection schedule: April 1st to 15th, 2021 2nd selection schedule: July 1st to 15th, 2021 3rd Selection schedule: October 1st to 15th, 2021

* Each candidate may only participate in one of the selection schedules.

Homologation of the registration: After analyzing the submitted documentation, the Program Coordination will decide on the granting of the registration requests, the result being published on the websites www2.ufjf.br/pgedufisica and www.ppgefi.ufv.br, up to 7 (seven) days after the end of the registration period. Only applications for registration that meet the requirements of this Notice will be granted.

4. Examining Faculty Board

The examining board of the selection process will be composed of two permanent professors from the Graduate Program in Physical Education at UFV / UFJF and will be published on the websites www2.ufjf.br/pgedufisica and www.ppgefi.ufv.br, up to 7 (seven) days after the end of the registration period. If the candidate identifies any link that corrupts the impersonality of the examining board, he / she must appeal within 48 hours after its disclosure. The examining board will carry out an evaluation of the candidates in all stages of the selection process and will respond to the appeals filed by them after the preliminary results of each stage are announced.

In all stages, candidates will be identified by an individual code generated after registration, and will no longer be identified by name or CPF.

5. Selection

The selection process will consist of the following Steps:

First Stage - Eliminatory and Qualifying

Evaluation of the Research Project in written form by an examining board composed of two professors, with a score from 0 to 100 points, with an eliminatory character for a score lower than 70.0 points and a classification for a score equal or higher than 70.0 points.

The evaluation will be based on the following criteria: 1) Theoretical foundation; 2) Objectives and / or hypotheses; 3) Quality and feasibility of the method; 4) Timeliness and adequacy of bibliographic references; 5) Schedule; 6) Financial viability; 7) Adequacy of the project to the research lines of the program and the intended advisor. Each evaluation criterion presented will be worth 100.0 points and, for the final grade of this item, the arithmetic average of the grades obtained in each evaluation criterion of each teacher will be calculated. Projects that do not fit the line of research of the intended advisor will be disqualified.

Along with the results of the first stage, the individualized day and time for the successful candidates' submission for the second stage of the selection process will be posted on the websites www2.ufjf.br/pgedufisica and www.ppgefi.ufv.br. The candidate must be available online half an hour before the scheduled time for his complaint and with access to a computer equipped with a camera,

microphone and internet that guarantee his participation in the process without interruptions. The candidate must present an original document with a photo before the beginning of this stage.

The dispute will be made via the google meet platform. The link to access the online selection questioning room will be sent by e-mail to the candidate by the supervisor who was chosen in the application.

In case the candidate does not attend, that is, if the candidate does not access the online meeting room at the time established for the online submission of his / her Research Project, he / she will be disqualified (the) of the selection process. The claim will be recorded, with storage guaranteed.

Disclosure of the results of the first stage: The results of this stage will be published within 20 working days after the registration is approved on the websites www2.ufjf.br/pgedufisica and www.ppgefi.ufv.br.

Second Stage - Eliminatory and Qualifying

Online submission of the Research Project and themes related to the researcher's line of research, with a score from 0 to 100 points, with an eliminatory character for a score lower than 70.0 points and a classification for a score equal or higher. more than 70.0 points. It will be carried out by an examining board composed of two professors.

The candidate will be accused of the Research Project by the following criteria: 1) Theoretical basis; 2) Objectives and / or hypotheses; 3) Quality and feasibility of the method; 4) Timeliness of bibliographic references; 5) Schedule; 6) Financial viability; 7) Skills and abilities to carry out the proposed Research Project; 8) Adequacy of the project to the research lines of the program and the intended advisor. Each evaluation criterion presented will be worth 100 points and, for the final grade of this item, the arithmetic average of the grades obtained in each evaluation criterion will be calculated.

Disclosure of the result of the second stage: The result of this stage will be published within 20 working days after the registration is approved on the websites www2.ufjf.br/pgedufisica and www.ppgefi.ufv.br.

Third Stage - Qualifying

Evaluation of the Curriculum Vitae, by an examining board composed of two professors. The organization of the curriculum must, necessarily, follow the script described below, being disqualified the candidate who does not do it. The vouchers must be attached in the same sequence as the Curriculum Vitae. The structuring and punctuation of the Curriculum Vitae will follow the following criteria:

1. Training (Total up to 30.0 points):

1.1- Doctorate (30.0 points each).

1.2- Master's degree (20.0 points).

1.3- Postgraduate Lato Sensu (5.0 points each). 1.4- Scientific Initiation Scholarship (5.0 points each). 1.5- Monitoring (2.0 points each).

1.6- Extension scholarship or PET (3.0 points each).

2. Research activities - works published and / or accepted for publication (Total up to 40.0 points): Obs .: For this item 2, only the last five years will be considered.

2.1- Scientific articles in an indexed journal [10,8,6,4,2,1,0,5 points each, respectively for articles classified in the most current Webqualis listing; Physical Education Assessment Area (Quadrennium 2013-2016), such as A1, A2, B1, B2, B3, B4 and B5]. When the candidate is the first author, there will be a 50% bonus.

2.2- Scientific articles in full in congress proceedings (0.5 points each).

2.3- Abstracts in journals and annals of congresses / symposia (0.25 points each, totaling up to 2.0 points).

2.4- Book chapter (4.0 points each, totaling up to 20.0 points).

2.5- Book (10.0 points each, totaling up to 20.0 points).

2.6 - Coordinator of a research group with CNPq certification (5.0 points). http://lattes.cnpq.br/web/dgp

2.7- Guidelines for Graduation and / or Specialization Course Conclusion Papers (1 point per work, totaling up to 5.0 points).

3. Extension Activities (Total up to 20.0 points):

3.1- Courses and lectures given (2.0 points each, totaling up to 10.0 points).

3.2- Participation in courses, congresses, symposia, lectures or similar (0.5 points each, totaling up to 10.0 points).

- **4. Professional Activities** (Total of up to 10.0 points):
 - 4.1- Teaching in higher education (1.0 point every 15 hours, totaling up to 10.0 points).

4.2- Teaching in elementary and high school and technical courses (1.0 point per year, totaling up to 5.0 points).

5. Filled Score Sheet - fill out the score sheet in Annex I, at the end of the Public Notice (failure to submit this duly completed sheet will disqualify the candidate)

6. Grade and Final Classification

The final grade will be calculated by the sum of the three stages of the selection process (Stage 1 +Stage 2 +Stage 3) and published nominally on the websites www2.ufjf.br/pgedufisica and www.ppgefi.ufv.br, in up to 5 (five) working days after the completion of the third stage. The final classification will be from highest to lowest grade.

- In the event of a tie between two (two) or more candidates, the tie will be broken by the highest score obtained in the First Stage.
- The list of approved candidates will be composed of the first candidates who occupy the positions of the supervisor indicated on the registration form.
- The list of surpluses will be composed of the candidates classified, but who have exceeded the number of vacancies offered by the advisor indicated on the registration form.

The Graduate Program in Physical Education is not required to fill all vacancies offered.

Results:

- 2nd selection schedule: until September 15, 2021
- 3rd Selection schedule: until December 15, 2021

7. Registration for registration

The approved candidate must deliver / send his / her documentation for registration and subsequent enrollment within 5 (five) working days after the disclosure of the final classification, with the Department of Graduate Studies in Physical Education of the Faculty of Physical Education and Sports at UFJF (for the approved candidate under the guidance of a professor linked to the workplace at UFJF) or the Physical Education Graduate Department of the Physical Education Department at UFV (for the approved candidate under the guidance of a professor linked to the workplace at UFV). The approved candidate who fails to deliver / send the documentation during this period will be considered a dropout and, consequently, the subsequent candidate will be called from the surplus list by advisor.

The respective Secretariats will send an e-mail advising the approved ones on the delivery / sending of the necessary documents for registration. In case of doubts, those approved must send an email to ppg.faefid@ufjf.edu.br (approved for UFJF advisors) or to ppgefi@ufv.br (approved) for UFV advisors).

The candidate from the list of surpluses, if called, by e-mail and / or telephone and / or by the websites www2.ufjf.br/pgedufisica and www.ppgefi.ufv.br, must perform the delivery / sending of your documents within 5 (five) working days, to the Post-Graduate Department in Physical Education of the Faculty of Physical Education and Sports at UFJF (for the approved candidate under guidance from a teacher linked to the workplace at UFJF) or at the Physical Education Graduate Department of the Physical Education Department at UFV (for the approved candidate under the guidance of a teacher linked to the workplace at UFV).

Candidates will have their registration effective after the final result is announced. The subjects to be taken must be defined between the candidate and their respective advisor. If there is no subject available by the beginning of the following semester, the student must enroll in "Research".

Documentation of the registration for the registration of the Foreign Candidate (a):

•All foreign candidates approved in this Public Notice must present, in the act of enrollment, a legible copy of the Master's Diploma referred to, front and back, or Certificate of the Hague Convention;

•All foreign candidates approved in this Public Notice must present, at the time of registration, a legible copy of the intended Graduation Diploma, front and back, or Certificate of the Hague Convention;

•All foreign candidates approved in this Public Notice must present a readable copy of the Birth Certificate at the time of registration. If married, a copy of the Marriage Certificate;

•All foreigners must present a legible copy of the CPF.

•All foreign candidates approved in this Public Notice must present a readable copy of the Passport with a temporary visa IV at the time of registration.

8. Roadmap for setting up the Research Project

The candidate must present a Research Project that fits the line of research of the intended advisor (see curriculum lattes of the intended advisor). The Project must follow the following script, restricting to a maximum of 12 (twelve) pages typed on A4 paper, font Times New Roman, size 12, 1.5 spacing:

Cover

- Project title.
- Candidate's CPF, without name identification.
- Name of the supervisor (a) to whom the project will be submitted.

Note: The cover does not count as the number of pages in the established limit.

1 - Introduction

Briefly report the problem situation addressed, citing data or information that may delimit your context. Justify your defense and line of action / theme (What ?; Why?). Submit an updated bibliographic review that objectively justifies the execution of the proposal.

2 - Objectives

State the objectives to be achieved by the project.

3 - Methods

Explain how the intended objectives (subjects, procedures and statistical treatment) are to be achieved. In addition, schedule and financial viability must be described.


4 – References

List the sources cited in the body of the project

Note: References do not count as the number of pages within the established limit. Consider 30 the number of maximum references that should be cited in the project. In addition, the attachments do not count as the number of pages in the established limit.

1. Results

No results referring to the stages of this Notice may be used in future Notices. They are exclusively for entry in 2021 and in the Notice (and stage) to which the candidate applied.

2. Resources

The candidate will have the right to appeal to the Postgraduate Program in Physical Education (UFV / UFJF) within 02 (two) days after the disclosure of the results of each stage. The form for submitting the appeal will be available at www2.ufjf.br/pgedufisica and www.ppgefi.ufv.br.

The candidate will be guaranteed the right to view the content of all the tests taken (written or not) and the respective score sheets, and may request access to copies of all documents related to the contest.

Resource requests must be made in writing, dated and signed by the candidate and sent to ppg.faefid@ufjf.edu.br (for candidates competing for vacancies with UFJF advisors) and ppgefi @ ufv.br (for candidates competing for vacancies with UFV advisors).

The granting or not of the appeal filed by candidate (a) will be published on the electronic addresses www2.ufjf.br/pgedufisica and www.ppgefi.ufv.br, websites of the Post-Graduate in Physical Education at UFJF and UFV, and the answer will be forwarded by email to the candidate.

3. Inform

The PhD course is offered in full association by the Federal University of Viçosa and Federal University of Juiz de Fora. Thus, the activities of the Courses are developed at both Universities, so that students must be available to move between the two institutions, according to the schedule of activities provided by the coordination and / or by (a)) Advisor). The doctorate course lasts between 36 and 48 months, except in exceptional cases with normative provisions.

After being admitted, the candidate has up to 24 months to take the foreign language proficiency exam, according to the regulations of the respective university to which the student will be enrolled (UFV or UFJF).
