The Association of Social Policies Studies (AVANÇAR) is selecting a professional with a newly concluded (or in conclusion) doctorate, to operate as a researcher on the Laboratory of Studies and Research in Social Economics – (Laboratório de Estudos e Pesquisas em Economia Social - LEPES).

Once it is approved by the Faculty, the selected professional will accomplish the post-doctoral internship by developing the research project around themes related to one of LEPES' lines of research, without any employment bond, under the supervision of Professors Daniel Santos or Luiz Scorzafave. The professional will be conceded a research grant from AVANÇAR [monthly scholarship value: R\$8,000 (US\$2,500)].

After the conclusion of the post-doctoral internship, the professional can be hired, at the discretion of AVANÇAR, as an employee, under registry and social security terms, for a non-determined period, in face of the evaluation of the activities developed along the internship [annual gross salary: R\$130,000 (US\$41,000)].

The desired profile includes:

- knowledge about advanced quantitative methods
- intellectual maturity to conduce great research projects with little supervision
- Formal Education in the areas of Economics, Psychology or Education, preferably.

The activities will be performed in the city of Ribeirão Preto (Brazil), with a 40 (forty) hours per week workload. In the end of the post-doctoral internship, when effectively hired, the researcher will be entitled to use 10 (ten) of the 40 (forty) weekly hours to develop research of their own interest (that means, without necessarily being related to LEPES research agenda).

The recruitment will occur through curriculum analysis and an interview.
