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PUBLIC NOTICE 02/2020

The Collegiate of the School of Administration and Accounting Sciences (FACC) Graduate Program in Administration (PPGA) publicizes the selective process for Academic Master's Course in Administration, 2021 class, regulated by this notice.

1. THE COURSE AND VALIDITY

- 1.1. The Graduate Program in Administration aims to provide critical formation of people capable of strengthening Administration education and research, as well as improving the management of public private and non-state public organizations.
- 1.2. The course has a concentration area, **Organizational Management**, divided into two research lines: **Line 1 - Management, Technologies and Organizational Processes**, which studies and researches the questions that aims economic, social, environmental and human developments of private, public and public non-state organizations, involving areas such as marketing, finance, production, logistics and sustainability, with the improvement of generic and functional strategies, focused on entrepreneurs and innovators business, considering the competitive business environment and **Line 2 - Individual, Organizations and Society**, which privileges, through historical, interpretative and critical studies, the understanding of micro and macroenvironmental processes in private, public and public non-state organizations. Such processes condition individual and institutional identities; shape power relationships, many of which express the antagonistic interaction between capital and labor; reinforce or mitigate social differences; delimit public policies, as well as coordinated movements of the civil society, in contexts marked by contradictions, complexity and plurality of actors.
- 1.3. The course is regularly offered in presential modality, but will be offered at Emergency Remote Teaching modality, according to the current rules, while endure the suspension of presential classes determined by the UFJF Superior Council, due to the pandemic of the new coronavirus.
- 1.4. The selection, from the approval, will be valid until the opening of a new selection.

2. VACANCIES

- 2.1. 25 vacancies will be offered, distributed among the categories: Wide Competition (13 vacancies), Quotas (5 vacancies), Foreign students (7 vacancies), as shown in Table 1.
- 2.2. Vacancies for the Quotas category are part of the inclusion and diversity policy of the PPGA, based on the Normative Ordinance of the Ministry of Education nº 13, of 11/05/2020, which regulates the induction of affirmative actions in graduate school; in the Brazilian Law of People with Disabilities Inclusion (Law No. 13,146 of 07/06/2015); and Law No. 13,005 of 06/25/2014, which institutes the National Education Plan (art. 2, items III and X and Annexes - Goal 14, Strategy 14.5).
- 2.3. Vacancies for the Quotas category are equally intended for the following groups, there being no subdivision among them:
 - I. People with African descent (People with African descent and mixed race Brazilians) and indigenous people, according to ethnic-racial self-classification.
 - II. People with disabilities, thus considered those who have a long-term disability of physical, mental, intellectual or sensory nature, which, in interaction with one or more barriers, can obstruct their full and effective participation in society in equal conditions with other people (Law 13.146, of 06/07/2015). If there is the necessity of biopsychosocial assessment of disability, this will be carried out by an UFJF multidisciplinary and interdisciplinary team.
 - III. Transvestites, transsexuals and transgenders, according to the self-declaration of gender identity.
- 2.4. Candidates who choose the Quotas category and do not qualify in the requirements expressed in items I, II and III of item 2.3, will be eliminated from the selective process or will have their registration canceled at any time.
- 2.5. Vacancies for the Foreign Students category are part of the PPGA's internationalization policy, in line with the Resolution of the UFJF Sectorial Council for Graduate Studies and Research No. 11 of 05/09/2018, which ratifies the UFJF Institutional Plan for Internationalization.
- 2.6. Vacancies for the Foreign Students category are exclusively for people born and residents outside of Brazil, and this condition must be proven, upon registration, by consular document.
- 2.7. When registering, the candidate must choose one of the three categories of vacancies, being the registration of more than one category prohibited, under penalty of elimination in the selection process.
- 2.8. If the total number of vacancies destined to the Broad Competition or Quotas would not be completed, these may be mutually interchangeable, at the discretion of the Collegiate.
- 2.9. Vacancies for the Foreign Student category can only be filled by foreigner candidates approved, not being interchangeable with the other categories.

- 2.10. The provision of false information by the candidate, ascertained after academic registration, will cause his/her cancellation at UFJF, without prejudice to suitable criminal sanctions.

3. APPLICATION

- 3.1. Application is open for the graduates in any courses recognized by the Ministry of Education (MEC), from any area of knowledge. Applicants with a diploma obtained abroad must provide recognition in Brazil.
- 3.2. The announcement of this selection notice will take place exclusively via the internet, and it will be available on the UFJF Graduate Program in Administration website: (<https://www2.ufjf.br/ppga/>).
- 3.3. The registration period will be from **06/10/2020** to **23/11/2020**.
- 3.4. Applications must be made exclusively by the Internet, from 12:00 on 06/10/2020 until 23:45 on 23/11/2020 (Brasília time), accessing the electronic address <https://forms.gle/tJdmwQtn93kW6fH98>, filling the application form and submitting all documents requested in item 4.1 of this Notice, in files with Portable Document Format (PDF). The documents must be sent in separate files and named in the same way as the words underlined in each topic of item 4.1 of this Notice, during the term of the applications.



- 3.5. After completing the registration form, an electronic confirmation message will be sent to the e-mail address provided by the candidate, along with his / her application code.
- 3.6. The adherence by the candidate to compete for the vacancies reserved for the quotas will occur voluntarily when filling out the self-declaration form according to the available model attached to this notice, and when choosing this option in the application form.
- 3.7. There will be no registration fee charged for this notice.
- 3.8. The candidate must apply for the vacancies offered by **only one supervising professor** mentioned in Table 1 of this notice. **In case of registration of more than one supervising professor, the candidate will be disqualified.**
- 3.9. The disabled person (PWD), even if he/she does not opt for the reserved places in the Quotas category, must inform his/her condition, at the time of registration, in order to be provided the conditions of accessibility and others conditions that enable his/her participation with equality in the selection.
- 3.10. The candidate's registration will imply his/her knowledge and tacit acceptance of the rules and conditions contained in this Notice, in relation to which he/she cannot claim ignorance.

4. REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION

- 4.1. The relevant documentation for application in the selection process must be inserted in the registration process by means of the available form, uploading the files. The candidate must attach the following documents (in PDF format):
 - a) Copy of National Identity Card or Driver's License, or Foreigner Identity Document, with all information in the same file.
 - b) CPF (Individual Taxpayer Register), which is not necessary if the number is included in the identity document.
 - c) Certificate of electoral discharge (<http://www.tse.jus.br/eleitor/certidoes/certidao-dequitacao-eleitoral>), in the case of Brazilian candidates.
 - d) For male candidate, certificate of reservist or certificate of exemption from incorporation, or certificate issued by the website of the Superior Military Court (<https://www.stm.jus.br/servicos-stm/certidao-negativa/emitir-certidao-negativa>) in the case of a Brazilian candidate.
 - e) Self-declaration form for the quota system applicants.
 - f) Diploma of the Undergraduate Course, recognized by the MEC, front and back, or Declaration of undergraduate degree, issued and signed by the responsible organ of the educational institution, together with a document showing the solicitation of the diploma, or a certificate that shows that the candidate will be graduated, at most, until the registration date, signed by the person responsible for the educational institution.
 - g) Transcript of records of the Undergraduate Course.
 - h) Full curriculum vitae from the Lattes Platform (<http://lattes.cnpq.br>), duly proven. Only activities with proof will be computed, and copies of these must be attached in the order in which they appear in the curriculum, digitalized in PDF format; Foreign



candidates who do not have the curriculum according to the Lattes platform standard must organize the curriculum according to the information that will be analyzed and scored in accordance with Table 5.

- i) Proof of the result of the Anpad Test - Test of the National Association of Postgraduate Studies and Research in Administration - with at least 250 points in the Portuguese test and 250 points in the English test.
- j) Alternatively to the Anpad Test, the following English language proficiency tests are accepted: i) FCE - First Certificate in English (University of Cambridge - GB); ii) CAE - Certificate of Advanced English (University of Cambridge - GB); iii) CPE - Certificate of Proficiency in English (University of Cambridge - GB); iv) TOEFL - Test of English as a Foreign Language: Paper Based Test with a minimum of 500 points, or Computer Based Test with a minimum of 213 points, or Internet Based Test with a minimum of 80 points; v) GRE - Graduate Record Examination; vi) TOEIC - Test of English for International Communication, with at least 600 points; g) IELTS - International English Language Testing System - British Council, overall band, with a minimum of 6.0 points; vii) Foreign Language Proficiency Test Certification (English) formulated and applied by a Federal Higher Education Institution (language test), with a minimum score of 7.0 (seven) out of a total of 10.0 (ten) points, or if this exam is given in percentage, 70% (seventy percent) if the test has a total of 100% (one hundred percent).
- k) Master's Research Proposal (pre-project), from 5 (five) to 8 (eight) pages, except the cover page, Times New Roman font, size 12, spacing between lines 1.5, top, bottom, right and left 2.5 cm, containing the following sequence: (1) On the first page (cover): Title of the Research Proposal, full name of the candidate and indication of the chosen supervising professor; (2) Second page onwards: Title, theme and justification for it; (3) research problem, general and specific objectives, and theoretical basis; (4) methodological aspects; (5) expected academic and social contributions; (6) schedule; (7) references, in accordance with the rules of the Brazilian Technical Standards Association (ABNT).
- l) If a foreigner comes from a country whose official language is not Portuguese, the candidate must also attach proof of proficiency in the Portuguese language, accepting the Certificate of Proficiency in Portuguese for Foreigners (CELPE-BRAS), intermediate or higher level, or a diploma of stricto sensu undergraduate or graduate course held in Brazil. He/she must also attach a valid identity document. Temporary or permanent visa is only necessary if approved and enrolled in the course.

5. REGISTRATION APPROVAL

- 5.1. Applications with incomplete documentation or that do not meet the requirements of this notice will be rejected.



- 5.2. The preliminary result related to the registration approval, the ANPAD Test, English language proficiency, and the research proposal will be published on 24/11/20, on the PPGA website.
- 5.3. The homologation may be appealed, by means of an appropriate electronic form, until 11:45 pm, Brasília time, in the period from 25/11/2020 to 26/11/2020, containing: 1) Candidate's full name; 2) Reasons for non-compliance.
- 5.4. The result of the appeal, as well as the final result of the registration approval, will be published on 27/11/2020, on the PPGA website.

6. SELECTION

- 6.1. The selection will consist of the following elements: 1) Anpad Test, which has an eliminatory nature; 2) analysis of the research proposal, which has an eliminatory and classificatory character; 3) defense of the dissertation proposal, which has an eliminatory and classificatory character and 4) curriculum analysis, which has a classificatory character.
- 6.2. The Anpad Test is developed and applied by the National Association of Graduate Studies and Research in Administration. The candidate will be responsible for registering and sending the Anpad Test grade to the PPGA. More information can be found on the Anpad Test website (www.anpad.org.br/~anpad/teste_anpad.php).
 - 6.2.1. The Anpad Test will be an eliminatory step, being selected for the next step all those who have achieved at least 250 points in the Portuguese test and 250 points in the English test (or minimum score according to the alternative English proficiency exams expressed in 4.1 - item i.).
 - 6.2.2. Candidates who obtain grade lower than the minimum required in the Portuguese and English tests will be eliminated.
 - 6.2.3. Candidates who obtain a score of 0 (zero) in any of the tests will be eliminated, even if they have obtained a sufficient score in the tests of Portuguese and English (Anpad or alternative English language test).
 - 6.2.4. If there is a need for a tiebreaker, the following criteria will be used: a) highest score in the Portuguese test; b) highest grade in the English test; c) older candidate.
 - 6.2.6. The result of the Anpad Test will be appealed, exclusively in cases of mistakes in the transcription of notes or similar, since the Anpad Test is organized and applied by a specific organization without PPGA interference or control, with the period for filing an appeal limited between 25/11/2020 to 26/11/2020.
 - 6.2.7. The final result with the first stage results (Anpad Test), after the appeal requests, and with the locations and the schedule of the interviews (academic merit) will be released on 27/11/2020.
 - 6.2.8. The foreign candidate is exempted from taking the Anpad Test. Conversely, he/she must present proof of proficiency in Portuguese, according to item "k" in 4.1.



6.3. The dissertation proposal defenses will be carried out **remotely** from 30/11/2020 to 02/12/2020. The places and the schedule will be published on 27/11/2020, in the PPGA website.

6.3.1. This stage will be recorded by devices that capture sound, with guaranteed storage, including backups, according to Resolution nº 06/2013 published by the UFJF Sectorial Council for Research and Graduate Studies (CSPP).

6.3.2. Candidates will be scored according to the criteria in Table 2, specified in Tables 3, 4 and 5:

Obs.: Candidates with less than 21 points will be eliminated from the selection process, not being called to defend the dissertation proposal.

6.3.3. For classification purposes, only the score according to the criteria in Table 2 will be considered, discarding the scores obtained in the Anpad Test.

6.3.4. The preliminary evaluation result of academic merit will be published on the 04/12/2020, on the PPGA website, containing the classification order and the candidate's number of application, the total grade and the grades achieved in each of the criteria evaluated.

6.3.5. The academic merit grade may be appealed by means of an appropriate electronic form, which must be sent until 11:45 pm, Brasília time, from 07/12/2020 to 08/12/2020.

6.3.6. The final result of the appeals, as well as the selection process, will be published on 11/12/2020, on the PPGA website, containing the classification order of the candidates by the registration number, with a total grade and the grades achieved in each of the criteria evaluated.

6.3.7. If there is a need for a tiebreaker, the following criteria will be used: a) higher grade in the defense of the dissertation project and b) older candidate.

6.3.8. An examining board will be composed by PPGA professors for evaluating the defense of research proposals.

6.3.9. The designated examining boards have didactic-pedagogical autonomy to conduct the evaluation process at all stages.

7. FINAL RESULT

- 7.1. Up to 9 (nine) candidates will be selected within the scope of the regular vacancies offered by the professors of each of the two lines of research of the PPGA, making a total of 18 (eighteen) approved and classified candidates. Approved candidates but not classified among the 18 vacancies may be invited by supervising professor in case of no enrollment effectuation concerning approved and classified candidates.



- 7.2. Regular vacancies unfilled by a teacher may be transferred to another teacher of the same line, after the conclusion of the selection process, at the discretion of the PPGA Board.
- 7.3. Vacancies in the quota system will be filled according to the classification obtained by the candidates. In case of no enrollment effectuation concerning approved candidate, classified candidates may be invited to fill vacancies.

8. APPEALS

- 8.1. The candidate may appeal at any stage of the selection process. At each stage of publication of results, an access link will be published to submit the appeal in a specific online form. In the event of any operational difficulties, the candidate should contact the e-mail mestrado.admacad@ufjf.edu.br within the deadline, always in accordance with Brasilia time.
- 8.2. The deadline for filing an appeal is up to 2 business days from the date of disclosure of the results of each stage.
- 8.3. Appeals will not be accepted after the stipulated date and documents sent with the appeal will not be analyzed.
- 8.4. The result of the appeals will be published within 2 (two) business days after the end of the appeal interposition period.

9. ENROLLMENT

- 9.1. On 11/12/2020, the Enrollment Notice will be published on the PPGA website, and the candidate must meet the deadlines and follow the procedures established there, under penalty of losing the vacancy.
- 9.2. To complete the enrollment, the applicant must submit a document that proves that he/she has a degree. Failure to submit it will make enrollment impossible, and the candidate will be excluded from the process.
- 9.3. In case of admission of international students in remote teaching mode, students will be exempted from presenting proof of regular migratory status while remaining outside Brazilian territory.

10. FINAL DISPOSITIONS

- 10.1. The omitted cases will be judged by the Collegiate of the Academic Master's Course in Administration, responsible for resolving the issues related to this notice.
- 10.2. Questions regarding this notice must be sent exclusively to the e-mail mestrado.admacad@ufjf.edu.br. Guidance or previous evaluations on the Dissertation Project and on the Interview, concerning the Academic Merit stage, will not be provided.
